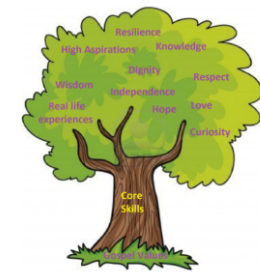


Nursery Curriculum Overview
